April Demonstrator Daryl Hosick



Daryl Hosick grew up in Hayward CA and graduated from San Jose State University.

His primary career was engineering and management and he was manager of a large organization developing electronics for the International Space Station and managed an organization responsible for "inventing" the next generation of commercial satellites. He holds five patents related to aerospace.

He has also been very active in the arts both as a painter and musician. He started his art career in the 1960's participating in the popular street fairs of the era working in an unusual media -- egg tempera.

Since then he has continued to improve his skills through workshops, classes and by producing and marketing many pieces of art. He is best known for his plein air work featuring landscapes and seascapes of the Monterey Bay region. He also produces studio pieces featuring seascapes and wildlife. He is a signature member of Monterey Bay Plein Air Painters Association (MBPAPA) and the Santa Cruz Oil Painters.

He enjoys sharing his knowledge with others and has written and published an art instruction book "Learn to Draw Using Perspective" which is available on Amazon. Our demo will apply this knowledge -- showing you how you how to capture the illusion of depth in your paintings by applying special drawing techniques and through color manipulation. His demo will be a landscape with a "falling down" barn and road leading into the distance.

For you interest Daryl is a professional jazz piano musician and is well known on the "jazz jubilee circuit". He has performed throughout the United States and the world including 16 years in the Sacramento Jazz Jubilee, the Monterey Dixie Fest, the Edinburgh Scotland



Jazz Jubilee, the Bohem Festival in Hungary, the Bude Festival in England, and numerous other music events.

Featured Artist For April Helma Zeuge



Born and raised on the German North Sea coast, Helma Zeuge has by now spent over two thirds of her life on and near the Pacific Coast of Central California. Arts and crafts have always been close to her heart and remained a hobby while she worked in the field of foreign language teaching.

Now retired, she pursues her artistic and other endeavors at her kitchen table studio. Here, you see an example of her Zentangle-pattern-inspired art done in ink and pencil. Other mediums she has used are watercolor, watercolor and other colored pencils, photography, video and more, while subjects range from abstract to land- and seascapes, from buildings to flowers and from people to animals.
