March Demonstrator Deborah Pierce



Deborah is a prolific, popular and well-selling artist who has been with the Salinas Valley Art Gallery since 2012. She grew up not far from Mount Lassen and Mount Shasta. Her fondest memories of those years were hiking with her naturalist/artist brother, Larry Foss, another popular painter. Deborah is mostly known for her large, impressionistic landscape paintings. Animals and people are included in many of her recent compositions.

She also loves "chiaroscuro", a Renaissance art technique using strong light and shadows. These effects are applied to another endeavor, still life paintings like the example on this page.

Deborah plans to show us how she approaches still-life paintings along with a few hints about how to acquire great, yet inexpensive, props.

With a little encouragement, Deborah may be willing to share some of her thoughts about how to best sell art. She is the most successful sales person at the Valley art gallery, frequently selling both hers and other artist's works.





March Featured Artist Lou Roman

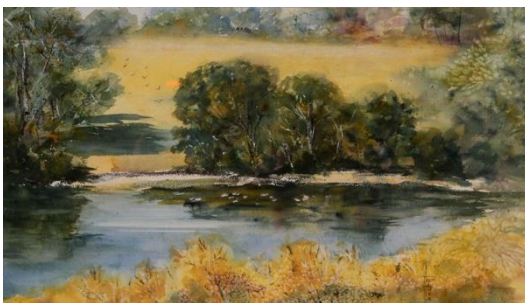


Points of Interest

Lou Roman's intense fascination with color is passionately blended in the "original California style".

Lou creates a mood the viewer can feel a part of through her impressionistic style and sensitive use of color. She finds the medium of watercolors especially challenging and sees her work as a constantly evolving process. She began her art career in California and has been an active full-time artist for over thirty years.

She has tastefully rendered a variety of watercolor subjects and her work is found in galleries throughout the US and in Hong Kong. Lou Roman studied under the most noteworthy watercolor masters at regional workshops in the US.
