Janeva Frisby



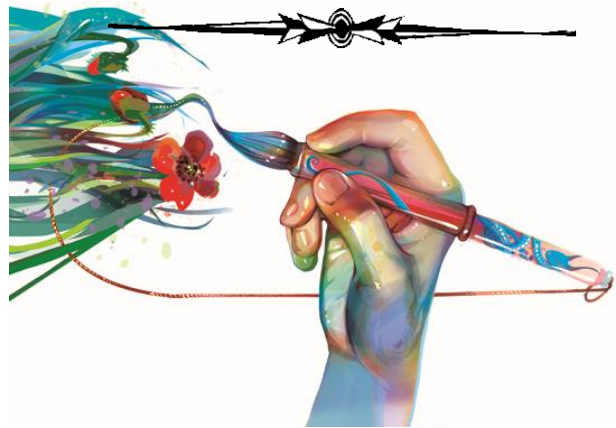
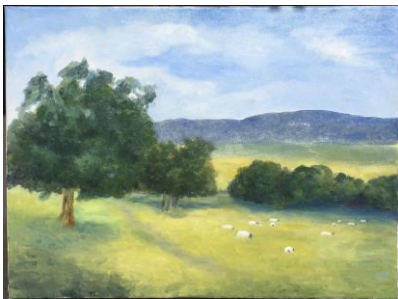
In 2013-14, when I was president of SVAA, I enjoyed bringing demonstration artist to our meetings and
